

Financial Assistance Policy

Sudbury Parks & Recreation Department strives to offer programs at the lowest price possible to run a safe, fun, and successful program. Even so, we understand some families may be facing a financial hardship. We have established a financial assistance policy allowing us to offer scholarships to those in need.

What is financial assistance?

Financial assistance is a scholarship for a reduced rate or fee for recreation programs and activities based on financial need. Scholarships are intended to help those who desire to attend Sudbury Park & Recreation programs but are unable due to the lack of sufficient funds. Scholarships may be awarded in an amount up to 15%, 25%, or 50% off a program.

Scholarships apply to MOST programs or activities with the following exceptions:

- Facility & Field Rentals
- Membership fees
- Program fees under \$15.00
- Some programs when a vendor is used.

Where do scholarships come from?

Scholarships are provided by the Sudbury Parks & Recreation Department. Scholarships are available on a very limited basis, as there is currently no scholarship fund. The fee reduction comes off the cost the Recreation Department receives at the time of registration. Available amounts vary by program, financial need, and the amount of applications submitted. The Sudbury Parks & Recreation department reserves the right to limit the amount awarded to an individual or family, especially if the demand by the community is high. The Parks & Recreation Director will review all applications and determine awards.

Who can receive a scholarship?

Scholarships are available to Town of Sudbury residents only. Scholarship amounts are based on the number of immediate family members in the household, their combined income from all sources, and whether or not you receive free or reduced lunch; other circumstances will be considered on a case by case basis. You may receive up to 15% off a program or activity if you do not qualify for free or reduced lunch but have specific hardships. You may receive up to 25% off if you qualify for reduced lunch. You may receive up to 50% off if you qualify for free lunch. The Sudbury Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to issue a scholarship outside the parameters set on a case by case basis.

All applicant's personal information is kept confidential. Class instructors and program leaders are not informed of participant's scholarship status.

How do I apply?

- 1. Complete the application form in its entirety
- 2. Attach supporting documents Director will not review or approve any application without proper documentation
- 3. Mail or drop off all information to the Fairbank Community Center, at least 10 days prior to registration. No applications will be accepted after the deadline.
- 4. Applicants will be notified within 3 business days.
